



The relative strengths and weaknesses of TYSON FOODS INC. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of TYSON FOODS INC. compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 129% points. The greatest weakness of TYSON FOODS INC. is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 120% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 219%, being 110% points above the market average of 109%.
