



The relative strengths and weaknesses of J&J; SNACK FOODS CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of J&J; SNACK FOODS CORP compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 87% points. The greatest weakness of J&J; SNACK FOODS CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 38% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 216%, being 108% points above the market average of 109%.
