



The relative strengths and weaknesses of U.S. GOLD CORP. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of U.S. GOLD CORP. compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 87% points. The greatest weakness of U.S. GOLD CORP. is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 48% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 187%, being 234% points above the market average of -47%.
